I had previously been the coach with the team since they were Under 7's. We have assembled a good team of coaches with a great deal of experience since James Parkin and Clay Harvey joined me as coaches, which has been a great help.

This is the first time that I have done any coaching at youth level. I previously managed and coached 4 or 5 local adult teams, which I found to be totally different to the needs of the youth footballer. I have been on a massive learning curve myself, which at times has been frustrating. We are now moving forward and seeing a lot of improvement in the boys' ability and skill levels. My involvement with Worthing Dynamos started when my son Liam joined the team in 2008. The manager at the time was looking for some extra help from parents and I put myself forward to help with training sessions. This assistance progressed to me being part of the regular help to the coaches and manager. I was keen to use my own experiences from Football and enthusiasm to help the squad in whatever way I could – including doing what we could to develop the team who struggled in the early days in the mid-Sussex League. I was offered the opportunity to turn my amateur 'on the pitch' experience into formal training when Dynamos supported me to complete the FA Level 1 Coaching Qualification. Once qualified the opportunity arose for me to formally take on the management and coaching of the squad – this was something I was really keen to do. This coincided with the team's transition to 11 a-side. I've tried to bring

some structure to the team and encourage them to develop their skills and teamwork – often we are learning together. I'm keen to continue to progress my knowledge and experience in the future.

Through these four seasons the boys have had tough times but we have all supported each other and worked on everything we could to better ourselves. Thanks go to Julian Church who has assisted me in the last year and a half with the coaching. The current season sees the squad playing some good football and with results to match (we are currently guaranteed a top 2 place this season). I get real enjoyment from seeing how the hard-work from training comes together on the pitch.
