

## Summary of Changes to Club Rules - August 2011

### General

All references to Extraordinary General Meetings changed to General Meetings in accordance with the Articles of Association.

Rules Renumbered as required and format tidied up.

1. *Remains as Rule 1* - Relationship of Congleton Rugby Union Football Club Limited to Congleton Rugby Union Football Club added for clarification.
2. *Deleted* – Covered in Articles of Association of CRUFC Ltd
3. *Deleted* – Covered in Articles of Association of CRUFC Ltd
4. *Deleted* – Covered in Articles of Association of CRUFC Ltd
5. *Becomes Rule 2* - Officer updated and reference to the Articles of Association added.
6. A) *Becomes Rule 3* - Updated to reflect true position and titles of GP Members. Reference to the President being the gift of the GP Committee as the conflicts with the Articles of Association.  
b) *Becomes Rule 4* - Updated to reference the Articles of Association and now only refers to offences which are not covered in the Rugby Football Union Regulations.  
c) *Becomes Rule 5* - reference to a sub-committee changed to Bar Committee
7. *Becomes Rule 6* - Change to The GP Committee shall recommend the acceptance of a potential new member to the Board. Reference to Article of Association 4 Liability of Members added for clarity. This states:

### **Liability of members**

The liability of each member is limited to £1, being the amount that each member undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Club in the event of its being wound up while he is a member or within one year after he ceases to be a member, for any of the items set out in Article 0.

The items for which the members undertake to contribute are:

- payment of the Club's debts and liabilities contracted before he ceases to be a member;
- payment of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up; and
- adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves.

The requirement to keep the Club informed of changes to contact details added.

8. *Becomes Rule 7* - Co-opting of other members to the selection committee added.
9. *Becomes Rule 8* - Unchanged
10. *Becomes Rule 9* - Reference to Rules 18 and 19 deleted. Reference to “Senior Players Under 18” removed as these are classed as Junior Members. Reference to “Female Playing Members” removed as this rule is not Gender specific. Reference to Membership via 200+ Club added. Classes renumbered accordingly.
11. *Becomes Rule 10* - Unchanged
12. *Becomes Rule 11* - Unchanged
13. A) *Becomes Rule 12* - Changed to facilitate the admission of Guests to the facilities in accordance with the Club Premises License.  
B) *Incorporated in to Rule 12*
14. *Becomes Rule 13* - Unchanged
15. *Becomes Rule 14* - Simplified and Changed to comply with current Club Premises License
16. *Becomes Rule 15* - Change to reflect the ‘reality’ of the current operations of the Club finances.
17. *Deleted* as reference to Members Liability is covered in amended Rule 7 and detailed in Articles of Association #4
18. *Deleted* as fully covered in the Articles of Association
19. *Deleted* as fully covered in the Articles of Association
20. *Becomes Rule 16* – Changed to provide more detail.
21. A) *Deleted* as covered in Articles of Association  
B) *Becomes Rule 17* - Unchanged
22. *Becomes Rule 18* - Unchanged

24. *Becomes Rule 19* - Changed to provide the GP with the ability to take on Financial Liabilities on behalf of the Members but not stating any limit. There was previously no limit specified. This may be altered at the EGM by amendment if a better wording is available.
