The committee welcome new players and parents and hope that they enjoy their time with the club, and value new ideas.

Players

- Achieve your best in both training and matches
- Listen to your coach -he/she is trying to make you a better player and has your best interest at heart
- Be respectful to others at all times and set a positive example to others
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat in the same way
- All players should know and abide by the rules of the game at all times
- Don't use any inappropriate language
- Be punctual at all times
- Players must pay their subs on a weekly basis to the manager
- Report any injuries to your coach or manager immediately
- Shin pads must be worn for training and matches
- Wearing of jewellery is not allowed for training or matches
- Treat the club's kit and equipment with respect at all times

Parents

- • It is your responsibility to get your child to training and matches on time and to ensure that they are collected on time Photography of any player is forbidden without the prior permission of both coaches and subject to the competition rules or regulations of the premises
- If your child has any injuries these must be reported to the manager
- Support for players should be positive and encouraging
- Set a good example by showing respect to the opposition and officials
- Don't attempt to coach any player, leave it to the manager or coach as this can lead to confusion
- Foul and abusive language or abusive behaviour in any form will not be tolerated
- • Parents should not enter the field of play or dressing rooms during or after the game unless asked to do so by an official Ensure that your

child's medical details are up to date and that the coach or manager is informed of any changes

- Any complaints or concerns should be reported to the manager immediately

Coaches / Managers

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat everyone equally within the context of the sport
- The safety and well being of each player is paramount and should be put before all other considerations including development and performance
- Coaches and managers should adhere to all guidelines laid down by the governing bodies
- Develop a good working relationship with each player and parent based on trust and respect
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Ensure that all activities are appropriate for the age, experience and ability of the players
- Ensure that players and parents know what is expected of them and what they are entitled to from you
- Co-operate fully with other specialists in the best interest of the player
- Promote the positive aspects of sport and don't condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the game or it's rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques
- Don't use or tolerate inappropriate behaviour
- Display high standards of behaviour and appearance at all times
