

INTERNATIONAL TICKETS APPLICATION FORM

CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE ALLOCATION TO AND USE OF INTERNATIONAL TICKETS BY CLUB MEMBERS.

Those who qualify to apply

The following applies to all fully paid up members who are also not in financial arrears of any kind to the Club. There are no life members of Paviors RFC; all membership is subject to the payment of the current subscription.

Sponsors qualify as Members because part of any sponsorship deals with Paviors RFC will involve a membership and the amount of that subscription will be transferred from the sponsor's contribution into the membership account.

Any sponsorship deal must fully conform to the RFU's terms and conditions which can be found at www.rfu.com/ticketing

Tickets will not be issued to anyone who does not meet the above criteria.

Qualifying members may apply for a maximum of two tickets per game by properly completing the application form which is available on the web site. This must be fully completed and no other form of application will be considered. Where a Member asks for a second ticket for a non member this will only be issued once all the Members applications have been fulfilled.

Issuing of Tickets

Please note, not all applications for tickets will be successful as demand usually exceeds the allocation we receive from the RFU. If this happens tickets will be issued based on the applicants contribution to the Club.

Subject to the correct completion of the form and the meeting of all the above criteria tickets will be issued subject to the following.

1. Tickets must only be used for those declared on the application form.
2. There must be no transference of tickets between members. All unwanted tickets must be returned to the Treasurer for issue to members on a waiting list.
3. It is the responsibility of those receiving tickets to comply fully with Pavior's, The RFU's and any current regulations regarding the use of tickets at such public events. Such information is available on our own and the RFU's web site www.rfu.com/ticketing. Terms and conditions are also displayed on the back of the ticket. By signing the application form you will be deemed to have familiarised yourselves with all rules and agreed to abide by them.
4. There is no guarantee that applicants will receive the tickets of the price requested and any adjustments to the cost will be made before the tickets can be issued.
5. All tickets must be retained by the recipient and handed back to the Treasurer within two weeks of the game.

Payment

A cheque payable to Paviors RFC should accompany the application. All cheques will be cashed. Refunds due will be made after the 6 Nations is complete. This is because more tickets may become available from the RFU or other sources and we may eventually be able to meet demand.

Ownership

The tickets remain the property of the Rugby Football Union until the person who has received them has gained entry into the ground and you have no right what so ever to sell them to others, even within Paviors, or transfer them at face value.

It is never too late to return tickets to the Treasurer. Even on the day the Club will refund the cost of the tickets to anyone who can not attend due to circumstances beyond their control. When the tickets are issued there will also be information regarding returning tickets on the day at the ground. The RFU will refund the ticket value less a small admin charge so no one need be out of pocket if the ticket is not used.

Paviors RFC will treat any breach of the above conditions very seriously and will always take appropriate action against those involved.
