What is the 200 Club?

Our Club always needs more funds than it can generate from subscriptions, which are paid mainly by young adult players or families with children. The Club budgets to cover its basic running costs from subscriptions but looks to sponsorship and donations to provide funds to grow and for the extra equipment, etc that we need.

The 200 Club is one of the ways we raise this extra money, which in future will go to the Club Development Fund to pay for the planned extension of our clubhouse. The extension will provide extra changing rooms and showers together with a larger social area upstairs in which to hold Club functions.

If you want to put something back into our Club and are able to provide some of the extra financial support we need and perhaps enjoy a flutter, then the 200 Club is for you. Once we have built the clubhouse extension, your generosity will continue to help provide equipment and the extra items we need for the clubhouse.

How does the 200 Club operate?

The 200 Club is a monthly draw, with a prize fund equal to 50% of the money collected and the balance going to the Club. You decide the amount you wish to pay in units of £1 and the Club collects this amount on or about 15th of each month by Direct Debit. The more units you have the greater your chance of winning. You can cease your payment and membership of the 200 Club at any time by writing to the Club or your bank, cancelling your Direct Debit Instruction. The draw is made on or about 20th of each month and you will be notified of the winners by email or you can check on the Club's website.

How can I join?

You can join the 200 Club by completing the Application Form on the next page together with the Direct Debit Instruction. Please include your email address if you have one. When completed, send the Application Form and Direct Debit Instruction to our Membership Secretary who will register the Direct Debit payment with your bank. If more convenient, you may hand in your forms at the Club bar.
