- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. This should include shinpads and suitable mouth guard.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members under the age of 18 are not allowed to consume alcohol on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Drugs of any kind will not be tolerated by the club.
