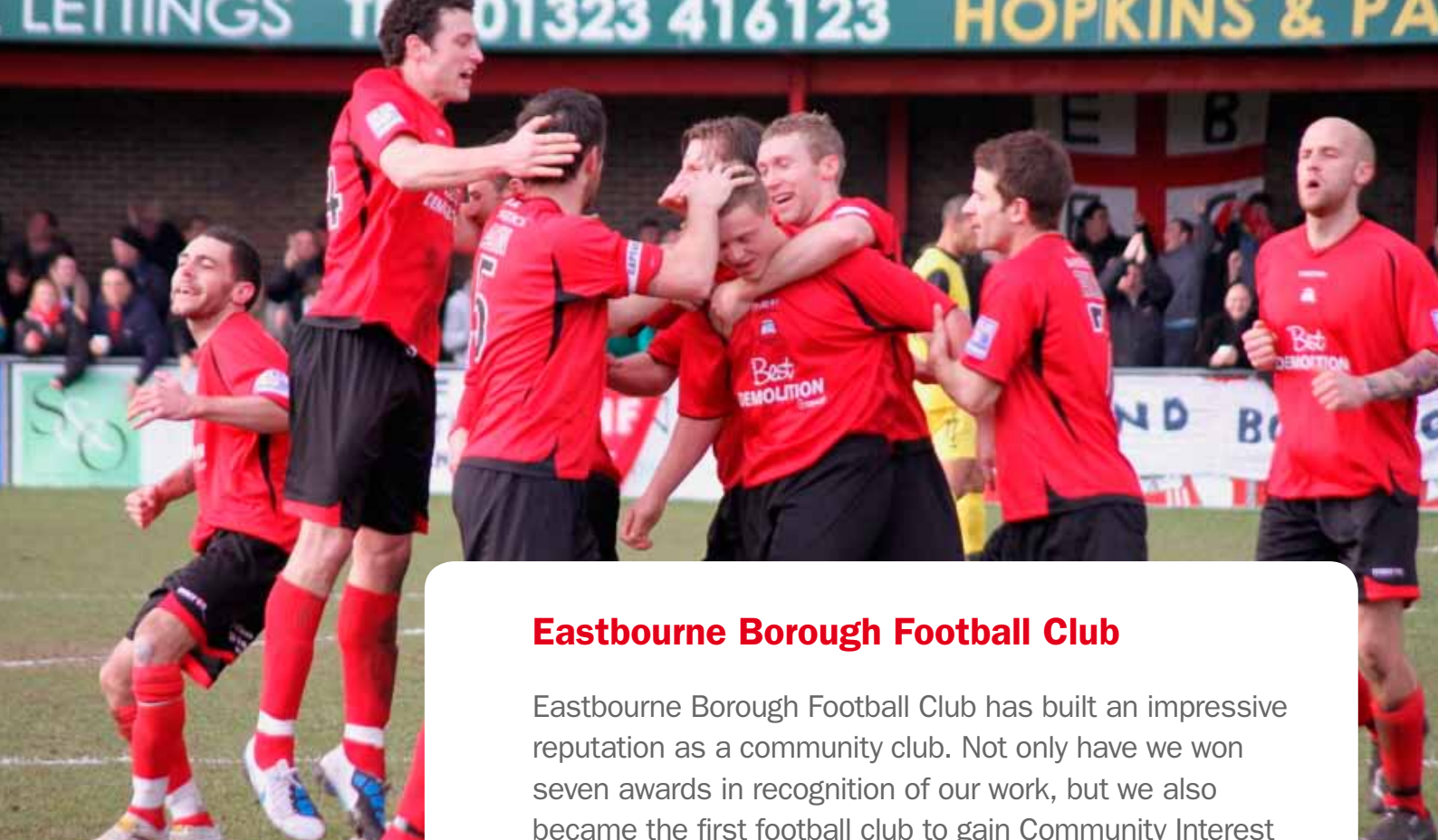

For five years in succession, we were named the Sussex County FA Community Club of the year, and twice won the FA South East Regional Charter Standard Club Award. We are proud of being the first winner of the Corporate Social Responsibility Award at the Eastbourne Business Awards, which recognises businesses who put something back into their communities.

## About EBFC

EBFC CIC started trading on 1 September 2008. In October 2008, the company took over the activities, responsibilities, staff, assets and liabilities of the existing EBFC, Langney Sports Club and Langney Sports Indoor.

The club was incorporated under the Companies Act 1985 as a private limited company on 23 July 2008. On incorporation, the directors were Chairman Leonard Smith, Stephen Carter, Michael Grimer and Michael Spooner. Since then, five new non-executive Directors have been appointed from various local businesses, bringing with them a varied range of additional skills. The Board of Directors will be subject to change at subsequent Annual General Meetings. The company's results will be published within three months of the end of the financial year and available at the Annual General Meetings of Shareholders.

As well as hosting Conference Football and the Langney Sports Club, our Priory Lane site holds an array of other activities, including archery, indoor bowls, Tai Chi, an afternoon club for the retired, Owlets Nursery and a study centre.

The club's heart and soul are the fans and supporters in Eastbourne's community. Their passion is shared by the players and by the dedicated staff of over 30 who keep the club functioning so effectively.
