



## **WOODSPRING JUNIOR FOOTBALL LEAGUE** **PLAYER REGISTRATION GUIDANCE SEASON 2011-2012**

- Registrations will be accepted from **WEDNESDAY 1 JUNE** but it would assist greatly if all forms relating to an age group were submitted together. Players who wish to change clubs after registration will be required to follow the League transfer rules.
- Players must have reached the age of **8 years** on or before **1 September** to be eligible for registration. Registration will be entered at the **minimum** age regardless of actual playing group. Any player registered for mini league **cannot** play in 11-a-side league.
- All registrations must be made on the correct form for 2011-2012. The form has been distributed by email to Club Registration Secretaries. **Please note that incomplete forms will NOT be actioned. Also forms must be in alphabetical order by age group when sent in.**
- Registration deadline to ensure eligibility to compete at the start of the season is **TUESDAY 23 AUGUST for U9/10/11 & WEDNESDAY 24 AUGUST for all other ages.** Registrations after that date must be deposited with the League Registration Secretary 3 days prior to a match and be received **by 8.30am on the THURSDAY. Forms received after that time will not be processed until the following week.**
- Those players who did not play in the Woodspring Junior Football League in 2010-11 are required to produce evidence of birth before registration. Copies of passports, birth certificates or any official document displaying date of birth will be accepted.
- Managers are reminded that it is an offence to play unregistered players and Rule 8g will operate. Some Clubs were fined and had points deducted in 2010-11 for this offence.
- Club Officials authorised to authenticate registration forms are the Chairman, Secretary and Club Registration Secretary only. Other signatures will result in rejection.
- Confirmation of registration will be sent to the nominated officer of each Club by email on the **Thursday** before weekend games. **No player may compete until the Club has received confirmation. It is a Club responsibility to ensure a player is registered.**
- Team Managers should be issued with a copy of this guidance to assist players in the completion of the registration forms.
- All enquiries relating to registration matters must be made through the Club Secretary or Club Registration Secretary and not directly to the League Registration Secretary.
- The Transfer Form now requires the releasing club to state whether the player is cup tied.
