## WRFC 1<sup>st</sup> XV WINNING STREAK ENDS

**Winchester's winning streak ended at seven games on Saturday when they went down 15 – 10 to Horsham in the second round of the RFU Senior Vase.**

Winchester had beaten Horsham comfortably at the same stage last year but was expecting a tough contest from a side going well this season in London South East 3. Despite this coach Andy Fields rested key players such as huge prop Danny Waite, lock Campbell Ettinger and captain and number eight Tom Pervin.

It was clear from kick-off that Horsham were prepared to play with width when they immediately attacked from deep. Winchester's defence, which has improved significantly, coped well with Horsham's attacking intent. The early signs were that it was to be a close game between two well matched sides.

Winchester gave up an early penalty when James Durman was penalised for holding on after a tackle. There were Winchester players nearby but none of them seemed keen to clear the ruck. Horsham stroked the ball comfortably through the posts for a 3 – 0 lead.

Winchester was struggling to produce quality set piece ball. James Webster, normally a tight head, was playing on the loose head and angering the officious referee. The lineout was not functioning as efficiently as usual and Horsham were putting in a hugely committed and quality display.

Winchester gradually worked their way into the game and began to dominate territory and possession. However, the Horsham defence refused to yield. Finally, on the stroke of half-time, the porcine Matt Woods slotted a penalty for a half-time score of 3 – 3.

The second half was a tense affair dominated by defence. Horsham gradually began to gain the upper hand and looked the more threatening side. Winchester's defence held firm until Will Self was penalised for not rolling away close to the Winchester line and was sent to the sin bin. Once again Winchester was forced to play with 14 men. Horsham took advantage of this to score their first try for a deserved 8 – 3 lead.



Winchester was now forced to try and come from behind with only 14 men. They were briefly down to 13 when hooker James Edwards, who has been playing well since nailing down the number two jersey, kicked the ball at a Horsham player in an inexplicable act of pique and was yellow carded. Horsham stretched their lead with a converted try to 15 – 3.

Winchester came back at Horsham ferociously in the last 5 min showing the committed attitude they have developed as a team. It was all a little too late though despite Will Self atoning for his sin binning when he strolled through and dotted down under the posts for a try with the last play of the day. He converted this himself for a final score of 15 - 10 to Horsham who were deserved winners.

Winchester now has to regroup ready for a top of the table league clash with Sandown and Shanklin at Nun's Road on Saturday, November 12. The game showed that there are still areas to work on particularly at the breakdown. Sandown and Shanklin will present a huge physical challenge and Winchester must front up to this and play with ferocity, pace and control if they are to come away with the victory. It is a game for all to look forward to and savour.
