

# RAIDERS RUGBY PARENTS AGREEMENT

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS

The undersigned and/or natural guardians of \_\_\_\_\_ (“Athlete”) hereby acknowledge their understanding that:

1. The club is a private, independent club or association.
2. From time to time, the Philadelphia Parks and Recreation Department and/or other private and public associations may permit the Club and Athlete to utilize fields and facilities. Such permission, however, shall not be deemed as sanction, sponsorship control or supervision of the activities of the Club.
3. Coaches serve at the will of the parent’s board and are expected to provide a controlled environment for Athletes to learn the fundamentals and skills associated with rugby football.

The undersigned further acknowledge and state that it is their wish that the Athlete play Youth Rugby under the sole and exclusive supervision and control of the Club and its coaches, representatives, and officers.

The undersigned further acknowledges that they are required to provide and show proof of first party medical and disability insurance coverage for the Athlete, and that no medical or disability insurance of any kind is provided by the Club or by any other source.

Now, therefore, the parents of \_\_\_\_\_ (child’s name) agree and intend to be legally bound to said covenant as follow:

1. Do hereby indemnify, hold harmless, release and forever discharge the Northeast Raiders High School Rugby Club and all of its coaches, representatives, officers, successors and affiliates and assign of and from any and all liability:
2. Do hereby further indemnify, hold harmless, release and forever discharge The City of Philadelphia Parks and Recreation Department as well as the City of Philadelphia as a whole.
3. Agree to provide adequate medical and disability insurance as set forth above.
4. Further state that we have carefully read the foregoing release and know the contents thereof and that we sign the same as our own free act and deed.
