



Aslockton Cranmers Football Club - Managers Code of Conduct

Managers and Coaches associated to Aslockton Cranmers FC are required to abide by the Code of Conduct set out below:

Managers and Coaches must respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat each equally within the context of the sport

Managers and Coaches must place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of performance

Managers and Coaches must adhere to all guidelines laid down by FACA and the Rules of The Football Association

Managers and Coaches must develop an appropriate working relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect

Managers and Coaches must not exert undue influence to obtain personal benefit or reward

Managers and Coaches must encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance

Managers and Coaches must ensure that the activities they direct or advocate are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of players

Managers and Coaches should, at the outset, clarify with the player (and, where appropriate, their parents) exactly what is expected of them and also what they are entitled to expect from their coach

Managers and Coaches must co-operate fully with other specialists (e.g. other coaches, officials, sports scientists, doctors, physiotherapists) in the best interests of the player

Managers and Coaches must always promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) and never condone violations of the Laws of the Game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the Laws of the Game or relevant rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques

Managers and Coaches must consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance Any breach of any provision(s) of this Code of Conduct by a member of Aslockton Cranmers FC shall constitute a breach of the Rules.

No junior or youth league football up to the age of under 14's is calculated on goal difference, with regard to league position or final standings.
