Paul gave out a breakdown of incomes and expenditures for this year. The current balance is £2048.71, £1000 of which was from an old account that was closed. We are still expecting money to come in from Surrige and Chance to Shine. There are concerns about membership not being paid and disorganisation with match fees affecting the balance. The fee for the Sports Club has changed this year in that we pay them per capita and fund our own maintenance of machinery and work on the ground etc. The Shirt Sponsors raffle brought in £2000 this year which can be improved on next year and fundraising through Golf Day went well thanks to Lee Ward.
