t20 competition rules

General. The YSPL competition will constitute a group stage of three groups of four clubs and a finals day. Each group winner will go forward to the finals day. In the finals day, the three group winners will be joined by the winner of the South Yorkshire Senior Cricket League t20 competition, and the winner on the day will go forward to the regional stage of the NatWest ECB club t20 competition.

Entry. Entry shall be mandatory for all clubs who are members of the YSPL, except where a club is excluded for disciplinary reasons.

Fixtures. The schedule, draw and venues for the competition are published in the 'Fixtures' section of this handbook.

Balls. A new ball will be used in each innings throughout the competition. The ball for the 2017 competition will be the pink Tiflex Oxbridge Magna ball, which will be distributed to clubs for the group stages and charged to the clubs at an agreed price. Balls for the league finals day will be provided and paid for by the YSPL.

Clothing. Coloured clothing shall be worn by all clubs throughout the competition. For clarification, equipment such as pads and batting gloves are not required to be colour co-ordinated.

Eligibility of Players. A player shall only be eligible to play in the competition if they are a bone fide member of their club and are eligible to compete in league matches. A player may only play for one club during the competition in any given season. Overseas players that have not been normally resident in the UK for a minimum of 18 months are not eligible to play in this competition. Any questions on eligibility should be addressed to the competition secretary before the semi-final or final.

Disputes. The committees' decision will be final and binding.

Rules. The competition will be played in accordance with the [Nat West club t20 rules](#).
