Last Saturday

Leaders Sheffield Collegiate maintained their unbeaten run at the top of the table with a DLS win in a rain-interrupted game at Chichester Road. Cleethorpes made a great start in chasing 239 in 38 overs, with openers Vusi Sibanda and Bill Kirby putting on 121 in quick time, but ultimately, and not for the first time, Billy Root was Collegiate's match-winner with both runs and wickets. Wakefield Thornes maintained their challenge just two points behind the leaders, making light work of Whiston, with Qaisar Ashraf leading the way with four wickets.

Appleby Frodingham gained their first league win of the season by ending third-placed Wickersley's three-match winning run. The visitors were bowled out 27 runs short in a 40-over game and are now 18 points behind Thornes. Wins for Doncaster and Hallam took them into joint fourth place ahead of Whiston, whilst Barnsley's win over Whitley Hall in the day's highest scoring game took them above both their visitors and Treeton, and they are now just four points behind sixth-placed Whiston.

Aston Hall's defeat by Hallam meant that Appleby Frodingham's win took them six points clear of the Green Lane side at the bottom end of the table.
