PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS A RESUME OF THE CASE. AT THE TIME OF WRITING (13/05/2018) WE ARE STILL WAITING TO RECEIVE THE WRITTEN JUDGMENT FROM THE RFU CHAIRMAN. SILLOTH WERE CHARGED UNDER RULE 5.12 OF THE RULES OF THE RFU – CONDUCT PREJUDICIAL TO THE INTERESTS OF THE GAME. IT WAS ALLEGED THAT THE REFEREE HAD BEEN SUBJECTED TO A VARIETY OF VERBAL ABUSE IN A VARIETY OF FORMS THROUGHOUT THE GAME; SOME BY PLAYERS, BY CLUB OFFICIALS AND BY SPECTATORS AT THE GAME. THE CLUB ADMITTED THE CHARGE AND OFFERED MITIGATION, SOME WHICH WAS ACCEPTED BY THE PANEL. THE PANEL ORDERED THAT THE CLUB BE FINED £400 & THAT THEY SHOULD ALSO PAY COSTS OF £125 PLUS VAT. OFFICIALS OF THE CLUB CLAIMED THAT THEY WOULD FIND IT DIFFICULT TO PAY. THE SECRETARY WAS ASKED TO CONSULT WITH THE COUNTY TREASURER TO AGREE A SUITABLE PAYMENT SCHEDULE, AND IMPLEMENT ACCORDINGLY. IN AGREEMENT WITH THE TREASURER SILLOTH, **MUST PAY THE COSTS OF £125 (PLUS VAT) ON RECEIPT OF THE INVOICE. THE £400 FINE MUST BE PAID AT £100 MONTHLY BY STANDING ORDER. INSTALMENTS MUST BE PAID ON THE FOLLOWING DATES – 1ST Sept, 1ST Oct, 1ST Nov, & 1ST Dec 2018. Any default in payment may result in further proceedings.** Note – on receipt of the full judgement from the panel chairman, this will be forwarded on.
