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NOTES:

Relating to the newly devised Match Report Form

- 1. COMPETITION** - There is no need to complete this part if the match is a league fixture. Only complete if Cup fixture or other.
- 2. PLAYERS NAME** – Fill in this column with player's first name and surname (in that order) and use block capitals, this makes it easier to read and understand.
- 3. GOAL TIME** – Indicate in this column if you wish the times of all goals scored.
- 4. CAUTION/DISMISS** – In this column indicate by placing either 'C' for caution or 'SO' for dismissal if a player is cautioned or dismissed and the time the caution/dismissal took place (although the time is not essential but it would be of help)/. If a player receives more than one caution then indicate this by placing a (C+1) etc in the appropriate box.
- 5. NOMINATED SUBSTITUTES** - In the column 'Sub Used' indicate in the appropriate substitutes box the No. of the player he is substituting (either **1** to **11**).
- 6. MAN OF THE MATCH** – The players full name is required, this is often forgotten or just a players number entered. It is relevant that a name is entered. Could you also name the club the player is from (duplicated I know but it would be helpful).
- 7. NAME OF REFEREE & MARKS** – Often this box is left empty. It is important that the name of the referee is entered as it may differ from the name of the referee nominated to officiate when the fixtures were first produced. There could be a last minute replacement. The marks awarded to a referee is also very important as this will affect his/her promotion prospects.
- 8. MARKING OF 5 OR BELOW** – If you mark a referee 5 or below then a letter to support the reasons why the mark is low must be sent to the league Referees Secretary (in this case: Scott Longley, 10, Ffordd Ty Newydd, Meliden. LL16 8PB. Post the complaint or email it to : scttlongley@gmail.com)

It is important to fully complete the match report form as the information requested on the form is necessary for administration purpose.

It is appreciated that the filling of forms can be an obstacle to some but please take the time to complete thereby assisting in the smooth running of the league and saving on being fined unnecessarily.

On the subject of completion of match report forms and the sending of the form to the Registration Secretary – I must remind you that it is subject to rule that the form is completed fully and correctly and submitted within 4(four) days of the completion of the fixture (Sunday not included) to the league Registration Secretary.
