In 2018, the ECB Small Grant Scheme aims to support the ECB's national programmes - **Get the Game On, All Stars Cricket, Women's Cricket** and **U19 Club T20**.

Priority will be given to applications from affiliated cricket clubs actively engaged with these programmes. All projects will assist clubs to make small changes to improve their long-term sustainability by increasing the number of games played, offering either improved family friendly social facilities, improved changing facilities for women cricketers or enabling great events for the U19 Club T20 competition.

Clubs should contact their local County Cricket Board (CCB) to receive an application form and guidance notes on how to apply.

The deadline for applications to CCBs is Friday 23rd February 2018.

In advance of next season, it is imperative that all accredited ECB Clubs and Leagues are aware of the updated information regarding Managed Migration in Club Cricket.

The ECB has been working with accredited ECB Premier Leagues since September 2016, assisting them with the monitoring and enforcement of the Immigration Rules set by the Home Office. Having reviewed levels of compliance as part of the ECB's 2017 season review, it is vital that ECB Clubs and Leagues take note of the information and assistance available to them.
